NOTIFICATIONS

New Delhi, the 30th October 1968

S.O. 3894.—Whereas by the Punjab Reorganisation (Chandigarh) (Adaptation of Laws on State and Concurrent Subjects) Order, 1968, made under section 89 of the Punjab Reorganisation Act, 1966 (31 of 1966), the Central Government has adapted certain laws in force in the Union territory of Chandigarh;

And whereas under paragraph 4 of the said Order, references to the State Government (by whatever form of words) occurring in laws other than Central Acts have been changed into references to the Central Government;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and all other powers enabling him in this behalf and in partial modification of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. S.O. 3269, dated the 1st November, 1966, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control and until further orders, the powers and functions of the Central Government exercisable and dischargeable under laws other than Central Acts shall, in relation to the Union territory of Chandigarh, be also exercised and discharged by the Administrator of that Union territory.

S.O. 3895.—Whereas by the Himachal Pradesh (Adaptation of Laws on State and Concurrent Subjects) Order, 1968, made under section 89 of the Punjab Reorganisation Act, 1966 (31 of 1966), the Central Government has adapted certain laws in force in the territories transferred to the Union territory of Himachal Pradesh under sub-section (1) of section 5 of that Act;

And whereas under paragraph 4 of the said Order, references to the State Government (by whatever form of words) occurring in laws other than Central Acts have been changed into references to the Central Government;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and all other powers enabling him in this behalf and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. S.O. 3370, dated the 1st November, 1966, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control and until further orders, the powers and functions of the Central Government exercisable and dischargeable under laws other than Central Acts shall, in relation to the transferred territories aforesaid, be also exercised and discharged by the Administrator of the Union territory of Himachal Pradesh.
